Please Note:

- Certain road accesses may be temporarily closed during the event for traffic control purposes. Please see map on page 9 for directions to site.
- At certain times during the recycling event, you may experience a short waiting time due to heavy traffic. Please be patient and we will serve you as quickly as possible.
- The following is the order in which materials will be unloaded at the event, please load your vehicle accordingly:
 - Used oil, oil filters and antifreeze
 - Textiles
 - Paper shredding
 - Carpet
 - Scrap metal and curbside recyclables
 - Tires
 - Fluorescent bulbs & batteries
 - Electronics
 - Mattresses & box springs
 - Appliances

Materials NOT Accepted:

- Garbage of any kind
- Yard and tree waste
- Window/door glass panes
- Plastic containers > 1 gallon
- Construction debris, paint, or other household hazardous waste materials identified by Staff.
- Furniture (except mattresses/box springs)

Fees will be collected at event entrance.
