Dear Peddler/Solicitor License Holder or Applicant:

On March 25, 2020, the City of Ramsey suspended all existing Peddler and Solicitation licenses. The City appreciates your patience and willingness to work with us during this COVID-19 pandemic. The City is excited to announce that we are reinstating all suspended Peddler/Solicitation licenses that are “door-to-door” or business-to-business” with some restrictions. *If you or your business have received this letter, your license has officially been reinstated.*

To help protect public health and reduce the spread of COVID19 virus, door-to-door peddlers and solicitors will be expected to follow certain guidelines. Peddlers and solicitors are responsible for complying with all Executive Orders and violations of Executive Orders are grounds for revocation. In addition:

- We strongly encourage peddlers and solicitors wear face masks.
- We strongly encourage peddlers and solicitors to maintain 6 feet of social distancing at all time.
- We expect that peddlers and solicitors take extra care to look for No Soliciting signs on private property.

As always, peddlers and solicitors should wear their city-issued ID badge and make sure it is visible when going door to door. Applications for new Peddler and Solicitation licenses that are “door-to-door” or “business-to-business” will now be processed in the order in which they are received.
